SIDE CLASSES AND SPECIALS

Stud – any entire male over 10 months

No white cat can be accepted at a FIFe show without a Certificate of Hearing. This will need to be produced during the vetting-in process

VACCINATIONS

All cats must be inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis, FVR and FCV. The full course in accordance with manufacturer's recommendation must have been completed at least 15 days prior to the show. You will be required to produce a current vaccination certificate for each cat exhibited

COMPLETING THE ENTRY FORM AND EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBILITY

Payment – All cheques are to be made payment to 'The Aristocats Club'. Payment can be made by internet banking. Please ensure the reference contains your name and the cats name so it can be easily identified.

Payment is due by Wednesday 23rd November. Any fees not received by that date will incur a tardy turtle fee of £5 per cat.

Amendments are free of charge up to the closing date; after this date there is a surcharge of £5.

Late Entries may be accepted at the discretion of the show manager for a surcharge of £5.

Cat Names - The full registered name (exactly as it is stated on the registration document, including any registration letter and/ or titles and awards) must also be stated on the show entry form. Awards and titles gained at the show are dependant on the correct information being available to the Show Manager.

Confirmation – Confirmation of entry will be sent to the Exhibitor by the Entry Clerk once their entry has been processed.

SHOW CLASSES - The Show Manager will enter your cat in the appropriate class according to information received. It is the Exhibitors responsibility to check their cat's details in the catalogue and if a mistake is found, inform the Secretariat before the judging commences, after which point it will be too late.



STEWARDED - Exhibitors will be asked to present their own cats to the judge, however help will be on hand if required.

Please ensure your cat is comfortable and always has water and a clean litter tray.
