### Show Fees

### Discounts

**Early Bird** - entry by Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> February 2011 - £4 per cat

**Aristocats Club Members** £2 per cat

**3 or more cats entered** £2 per cat (max discount £8)

### Side Classes

These will be held separately on both Saturday and Sunday.

**Stud** - any entire male over 10 months

**Queen** - any entire female over 10 months

**Neuter** - any neutered cat over 10 months

**Kitten** - any kitten aged 3-10 months

**Litter** - 3 or more kittens from the same litter  
aged 3-10 months

**Veteran** - any cat aged 7 years or over

**Adolescent** - any cat over 10 months but less than 2 years

**Breeder** - any cat exhibited by the breeder

**Exhibitor** - any cat **not** exhibited by the breeder

**Members** - any cat exhibited by an Aristocats member

**Debutante** - any cat that hasn't previously been shown at an Aristocats show

**Novice** - any cat that has not won a 1<sup>st</sup> place in a FIFe show

*All side classes with 10 entries, or in the case of the Litter Class with at least 3 litters, will qualify for a £25 cash prize for the class winner.*



## Rosettes

For this show the club will be giving rosettes only for Best in Variety, Nominations and Best in Show.

*If you require class rosettes these can be purchased in advance by adding £1.75 per class to your Entry Fee.*

## Important - Vetting-in

Times - strictly 7.30am - 8.30am.

*Cats must be in their pens by 9.00am.*

## Vaccinations

All cats must be inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis, FVR and FCV. The full course in accordance with manufacturer's recommendation must have been completed at least 15 days prior to the show. You will be required to produce a current vaccination certificate for each cat exhibited.

## White Cats

No white cat can be accepted at a FIFe show without a Certificate of Hearing. This will need to be produced during the vetting-in process.

## Completing the Entry Form & Exhibitors Responsibility

**Payment** - All cheques are to be made payable to 'The Aristocats Club'

**Entry Changes** - May be made up to 10 days prior to the show for an Administration fee of £5.

**Amendments** - free of charge



**Cat Names** - The full registered name (exactly as stated on the registration document, including any registration letter and/or titles and awards) must also be stated on the show entry form. Awards and titles gained at the show are dependant on the correct information being available to the Show Manager.

**Confirmation** - It is the Exhibitors responsibility to ensure that an entry has been accepted. A stamped self addressed envelope enclosed with the entry is recommended.

**Show Classes** - The Show Manager will enter your cat in the appropriate class according to information received. It is the Exhibitors responsibility to check their cat's details in the catalogue and if a mistake is found, inform the Secretariat before the judging commences, after which point it will be too late.

**Stewarding** - Exhibitors will be asked to present their own cats to the judge, however help will be on hand if required. Numbered tallies that will be in the envelope you receive at vetting-in can be worn around the cats neck with ribbon or alternatively around the presenters wrist.

***Please ensure your cat is comfortable and always has water and a clean litter tray.***
